



Would you have sexual encounters with persons infected with HIV or AIDS 60 responses




Would you kiss persons with HIV or AIDS




Would you hold hands with someone who has HIV or AIDS


How do you know someone HIV Status




Would you drink after a person infected with HIV or AIDS




Would you use a public toilet after someone infected with HIV or AIDS




Would you agree the community needs to be more educated on the dangers of HIV & AIDS
















Do you know your HIV Status




Do you feel knowing your status is important




Would you tell your family or friends you're HIV positive




Would you tell your sexual partner your're HIV positive




Do you get tested each year




Do you have unprotected sex
